EVEN THOUGH HE HAD ONLY ONE LEG AND WAS IN POOR HEALTH AND CONFINED TO THE HOLLY PATERSON NURSING HOME HE CONTINUED TO FUNCTION AS THE THIRD VICE COMMANDER OF THE POST USING A LAP TOP COMPUTER AND A TELEPHONE.

THE HONOR OF THIS AWARD WAS WELL EARNED AND TOM WOULD HAVE BEEN PROUD TO ACCEPT IT. BUT TOM PASSED AWAY THE NIGHT BEFORE HE WAS TO BE AWARDED THE HONOR.
